



Board Policy: Parental School and Classroom Visits HB2025

In accordance with H.B. 2025, Academy with Community Partner's (ACP) policy for parental classroom visits, tours and observations outlined below.

ACP believes that parents are our partners in the education process. Parents are welcome to visit, tour and observe the classroom. The following is important to make sure that our focus is on the learning of students and that the environment is conducive to it.

- Parents are welcome to come visit a classroom but must sign in at the office to get a visitor's sticker. If parents are visiting or observing, we ask that they refrain from interrupting the class by talking to students or the teacher. If a parent wishes to conference with the teacher, they should contact the teacher through the office or by email to schedule at a time during lunch or after school.
- To request a school tour, a parent should call the office and talk to the office manager for time with our enrollment counselor. Our school tours are open with guidelines and precautions in place to protect the health and safety of our community and staff. Precautions include:
 - Social distancing when possible
 - Regular deep cleaning of our campus and hand sanitizing is available
 - The wearing of face coverings is optional
